


Saint Francis of Assisi

Demi is an award-winning children’s book author and illustrator. She has published over 130 books during her career. Born in Cambridge, MA, she studied art at the Instituto Allende, Mexico; with Sister Corita at the Immaculate Heart College in Los Angeles; and was a Fulbright scholar at the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, India where she received her Master’s degree. Well known for her biographies of pivotal historical and spiritual figures such as Krishna, Lao Tzu, Jesus, Mary, Muhammad, Rumi, Gandhi, and the Dalai Lama, her book *The Empty Pot* was selected by former First Lady Barbara Bush in 1990 as one of the books to be read on the

ABC Radio Network Program *Mrs. Bush’s Story Time*, sponsored by the Children’s Literacy Initiative.

In 1990, both Demi and her husband, translator Tze-si “Jesse” Huang, represented the United States at the First Children’s International Book Conference in Beijing.
